Our Mission and Accomplishments

The Hong Kong Holocaust and Tolerance Centre (HKHTC) is a non-profit organization dedicated to the promotion of Holocaust awareness and advancing tolerance in society.

With discrimination, hate speech and genocide still present in the 21st century, the lessons of the Holocaust remain universal, timeless and highly relevant. Founded in 2011, HKHTC pursues its mission through:

- Holocaust survivor visits to Hong Kong and Greater China, including local schools, universities and community organizations
- Extensive educational programming about the Holocaust and other acts of genocide
- Lectures at Hong Kong schools and universities by academics
- Organization and hosting of the annual UN Holocaust Memorial Day and Yom Hashoah commemorations
- Screenings of Holocaust and genocide related films at film festivals and in schools
- Holocaust-themed exhibitions at major venues
- Cooperation with leading international entities, such as Yad Vashem and Anne Frank House
- Holocaust-related lectures and events in the Greater China Region
- Coordination of a Hong Kong delegation for the annual March of the Living
